Description:	Leukemia Inhibitory Factor (LIF) is a member of the IL-6 family and a pleiotropic cytokine with roles in several different systems. It is involved in the induction of hematopoietic differentiation in normal and myeloid leukemia cells, induction of neuronal cell differentiation, regulator of mesenchymal to epithelial conversion during kidney development, and may also have a role in immune tolerance at the maternal-fetal interface.

Reconstitution:	Centrifuge vial prior to opening. Add sterile 10mM acetic acid to a concentration of 0.1 mg/ml. DO NOT VORTEX. Allow several minutes for complete reconstitution. Further dilution should be made in appropriate buffered solutions.		

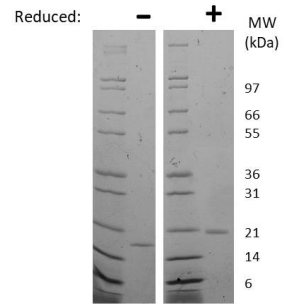
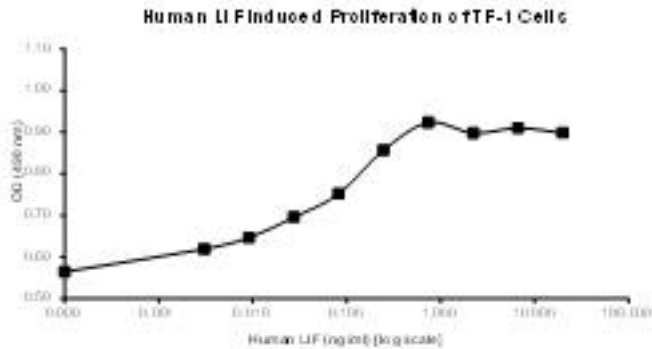


Storage & Stability:

Lyophilized product is stable at room temperature for shipping purposes. Store as supplied at -20°C to -80°C for up to 1 year.

Upon reconstitution, the preparation is stable for up to one month at 2-8°C. For long term storage, freeze in working aliquots and store at -20 to -80°C. For maximal stability, dilute to working aliquots in a 0.1% BSA solution.

Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
